I am writing with reference to Amnesty International's letter dated 26th November, 2019. I would like to thank you for acknowledging the initiatives of Government of Pakistan to tackle the issue of air pollution.

You would be pleased to know that we have decided to shift away from polluting transport by urgently improving the quality of imported fuel (Euro 2 to Euro 4/5), as well as framing our first electric vehicle policy (targeting a 30% shift to electric by 2030). Furthermore, the world's first "zero emissions" metro line project has been recently initiated for Karachi and is the first transport project of the Green Climate Fund.

I want to assure you that our Ministry is committed to play its role for shifting the landscape in Pakistan towards a cleaner, greener and sustainable future and particularly targeting the growing challenge of air pollution and climate change.
